## Referee Ranking

### **Goals and Objectives**

- § Satisfactory performance on the referees decisions
- § Referee selection for all medals matches
- § European championships only with selected and invited Referee's, according ranking system
- § Development of a strong and competent referee core group

The ranking system is a points based evaluations awarded or deducted over a two year performance, the ratings areas are according the referee requirement profile.

### **Technical Competence**

- § Ability to see points, contact assessment, rule application, signal's and command's

### **Social Competence**

- § Teamwork and communication, Stress management

### **Personality**

- § Timing and reaction, Confidence, Taking responsibility, Match control

The evaluation's will be done continually, throughout every day of the championships, (Junior and Senior or official EKF appointed tournaments) by the responsible MACs under the direct supervision and responsibility of an RC member.

The average of all tournament days will be the definitively ranking evaluation for each Referee (average of each MAC+RC evaluation)

Ranking area = total points per years / divided per the amount of tournaments

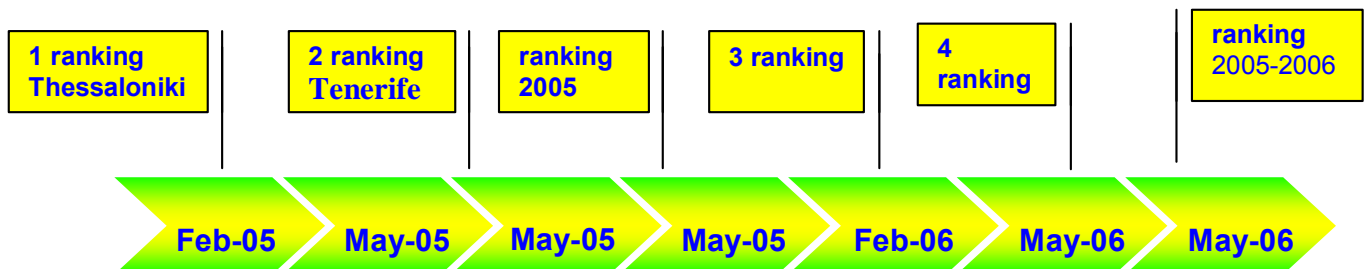
**Ranking area are fixed for two years**

## Ranking area structure

- § First level MAC (Match Area Controller)
- § Top 20 group
- § 21-40 group
- § 41-80 and 81-120

the maximal referees contingent per country in the top 20 group is two, based on the best scores placed.

## **Time schedule for the official introduction by EKF**



In 2006 the EKF- RC – plan to expand the ranking evaluation to other EKF official appointed tournaments, so that a large amount of referee could have the possibility to be in the ranking system. The information about tournament who referees performance can be evaluated for the ranking, will be send by the RC - secretary.
