Cadets, Juniors, U21

Modus Kata:

Elimination (K.O.) system with repechage in all categories. Competitors choose Kata on their own. Back-to-back different Kata must be performed.

Special regulation Kata Individual U10, U12 and U14:

Up to the semi-final both fighters (AKA and AO) must present their Kata at the same time on the tatami.

- U10: three different Kata
- U12: three different Kata
- U14: four different Kata

Cadets, Juniors, U21: WKF rules

Kata Team Cadets & U21 follow the same rules as WKF Kata Team Juniors
Bunkai in medal fights obligatory for Kata Team categories U14 and older.

Modus Kumite:

Kumite U12, U14: Groups will be arranged depending on weight.
Exact fighting time: 1,5 minutes

Cadets, Juniors, U21: WKF rules

Kumite Team categories basically follow the WKF rules for Individual Kumite and senior Kumite Team categories (but with only 3 competitors). It is allowed to build a team existing of competitors from different dojo from the same country.
Each competitor can only be announced in one team.
No repechage in the categories Kumite Open and Kumite Team!

Compulsory Kumite Protective Equipment

Karate mitts, shin pad and foot protectors (red/blue), body protector, chest protector (only female) and gum shield.

No Face Mask!

Condition for participation

All athletes with valid membership card of their national federation. Coaches/Carers are responsible for medical certificates and parents consents.

Age limit appointed date: June 24th/25th 2017

Graduation limit: 6. Kyu for Kata categories / 5.Kyu for Kumite categories

Participation Fee: Individual € 25,- if registered online until Monday, June 12th 2017.
Team € 35,- if registered online until Monday, June 12th 2017.

Double entry fee for the following two cases:

1. Changing a competitor during the registration in another category is allowed only on Friday, June 23rd 2017.
2. We accept online registrations up to the limit of 1200 entries which we get in our possession between 13th and 21st of June.

Triple entry fee:

- Registration of new (individual) competitors during the official registration process on Friday.

No new registrations or changes possible on Saturday and Sunday!
